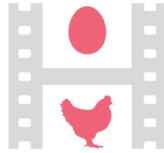

## BEFORE YOU BEGIN

The Chicken & Egg Pictures Research & Development Grant is intended to provide financial support to filmmakers with a proven track record as they take the time and space to think, research and develop new ideas.

**Based on your current project stage, you can submit an application for either a Research Grant (\$10,000) or a Development Grant (\$20,000).** To help you determine which grant to apply to, please review carefully the [Guidelines & Criteria](#) as they contain our proposed definitions and core activities associated with each stage.

The purpose of the Research & Development Grant is to support projects at the early stages of their lifecycle. If you have already raised a substantial amount of capital (over 35% of your film's total budget), and have shot and/or edited a substantial amount of footage, you may not be competitive for this grant, unless you can demonstrate very specific needs for the project (such as previously overlooked research activity).

We recognize that each documentary is unique and that processes for research and development, fundraising and production vary widely. This description provided here is not intended as strict eligibility criteria, but rather as general guidelines to help applicants understand the stage at which we aim to provide support for projects.

Most of the questions are shared across both applications, but some questions are specific to each. Most questions are based on the [Nonfiction Core Application 2.0](#), with a few supplemental questions. Please note, the Development Grant Application asks an additional set of questions to collect more detailed information about the project. We have separated the Research Grant from the Development Grant to allow early-stage projects to receive support without the need to submit all the deliverables required by projects in the development phase.

Give an overview of the subject matter and your primary questions and ideas to be explored. Please be clear about the elements of your film that remain unknown or unclear and highlight the questions that may steer the direction of your film.

### Change and Impact Statement

Chicken & Egg Pictures envisions an equitable and just world shaped by the power of documentary film. We support films that help create social change and/or uplift underrepresented stories that challenge mainstream narratives. Therefore, we would like to understand how you see this film having an impact in creating change. We are not asking for an impact campaign idea or activities, but rather an overarching goal. What is the kind of change your film seeks to create? What is the impact that you hope your film will have? What would change as a result if you are successful?

## PRIOR WORK

The filmmaker must have directed at least one completed feature-length documentary or non-fiction film (this includes hybrid docs). Prior work must have been independently produced; however, commissioned documentaries and television documentaries, including those produced for news/journalism outlets, are eligible to be considered as prior work if the director had directorial control

Fiction work, music videos, and PSAs are not accepted as prior work. We value the creative value of this work but because of its nature it does not allow us to see your author's voice and your vision as a documentary director.

Please provide information for prior feature-length documentary films you have directed. We consider a feature-length documentary to be **48 minutes or longer**. You must provide a link to **at least one feature-length documentary film** in which you participated as a director or co-director. If you have directed additional feature-length films, you can provide information for up to 2 additional works.
